Generous Slice is a free cafe and although we accept donations, which are used simply to cover costs, we don't see it as a fundraiser but as an offering to the community. So, if you've dropped children off at school, or you're on your own and would like some company, or you'd like a place to meet friends locally - there's a place that's warm, welcoming and serving good coffee and it's Generous Slice.....

**Barton Village Harvest Thanksgiving**, 18<sup>th</sup> September, 9.30 am in church. We will be collecting food items for the Cambridge Food Bank and these can also be brought to the church on Saturday or Sunday. There is a list in church of items needed.

**In the steps of the Bishop** Saturday 24 September 2016. The 8<sup>th</sup> Annual sponsored walk 'In the steps of the Bishop' will take place on 24<sup>th</sup> September. Starting from Gonville & Caius College Chapel at 10.30 am, the Walk will finish at All Saints' Haslingfield where refreshments will be awaiting tired and hungry walkers. The walk commemorates one taken by Bishop Charles Mackenzie when he was assisting the Vicar at Haslingfield before he left for Africa in 1855. He established his base at Magomero in what is now Malawi, and the Church now raises funds for projects in that village. Currently we are raising money for a new teacher's house at the Bishop Mackenzie School. Forms for sponsoring walkers will be available shortly in the Church, and all are invited to help us.
